November Annual Clean-up of illegal Marijuana grows on Public lands Central Sierra, Madera County Breakdown

Operation Synopsis: November 12-18th, 2016

Governmental Organizations involved: California Department of Fish and Wildlife (Law Enforcement Division & Wildlife Investigations Laboratory), US Forest Service law Enforcement, Recreation and Research divisions and the California National Guard.

Non-Governmental Organizations involved The Environmental Reclamation Team of the High Sierra Volunteer Trail Crew (ERT) and the Coarsegold Resource Conservation District.

Support: Logistical and financial support was contributed by the above-mentioned entities. Funding for the scientific documentation and reclamation of trespass marijuana sites was provided through grants from the Chukchansi Indian tribe administrated by the Yosemite Sequoia Research and Development Council with the following goals:

- 1. Remediate previously raided or partially cleaned up sites.
- 2. Document and remove all toxicants found.
- 3. Remediate and dismantle cultivation sites to restore habitat and remove risks to wildlife.
